2007-2008 Academic Report



A Catholic education is a rigorous education. High standards, strong motivation, effective discipline and a caring atmosphere combine to foster excellence, and a high quality of student performance is supported by the evidence.

- Catholic School students score significantly above the national averages on standardized testing.
- Research shows that because of a greater emphasis on homework and study, Catholic School students develop more effective writing skills.
- Catholic Schools have an excellent success rate in educating minority students.
- Catholic School students have a 99.1% high school graduation rate, as compared to a 71% rate for public school students (86.5% if GED certificates are included.)

While providing a stimulating and challenging education, Catholic Schools give students a high level of individualized attention and personal sharing.

Dedicated Teachers

At Assumption Catholic School, our teachers are a key element in our success. Together they create a positive educational atmosphere throughout the school. Their dedication is recognized by students and parents, as well as by their peers. In 2008, Mrs. Betsy Gottschalk was named Washington State History Teacher of the Year by the Gilder Lehrman Institute of American History and Preserve America. An inspirational middle school teacher at Assumption for the past 19 years, Mrs. Gottschalk is now a candidate for national History Teacher of the Year. She credits the entire Assumption Faculty for her success.

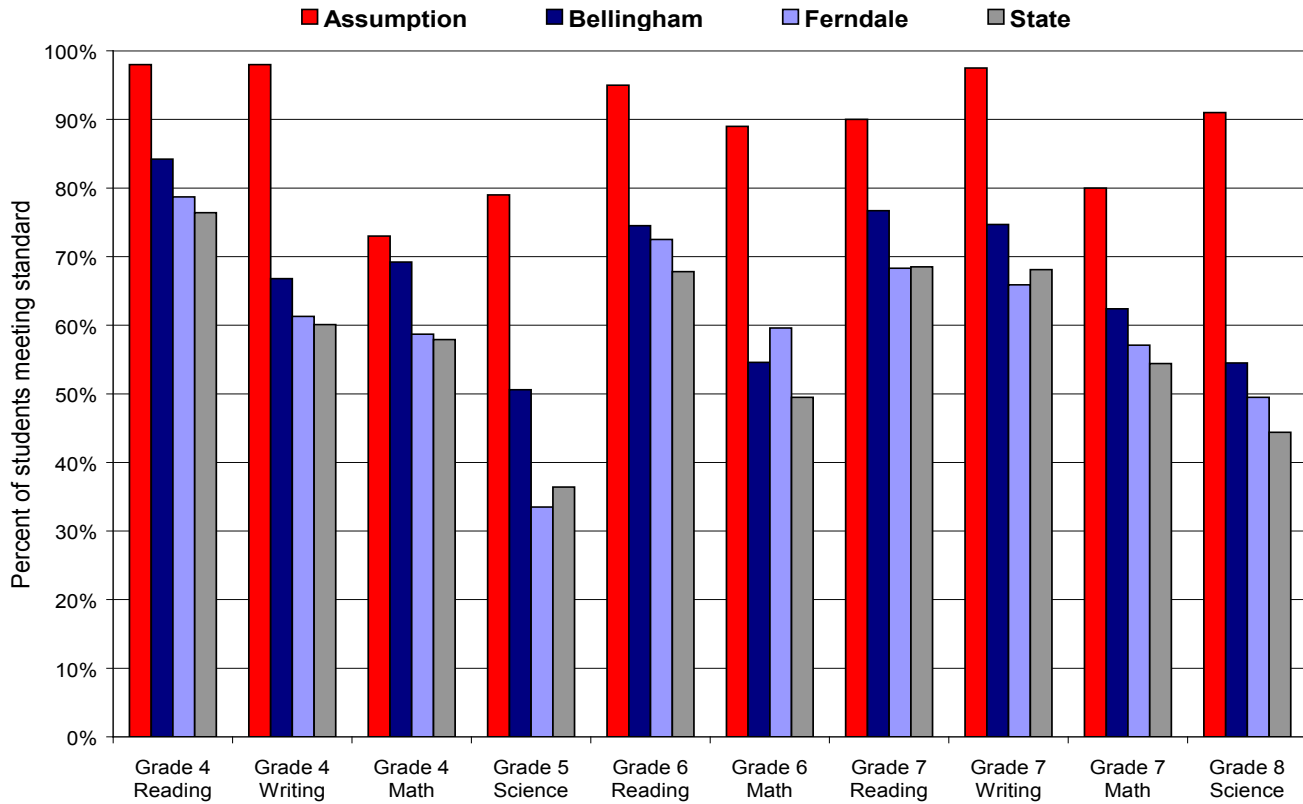

2007 WASL Comparisons



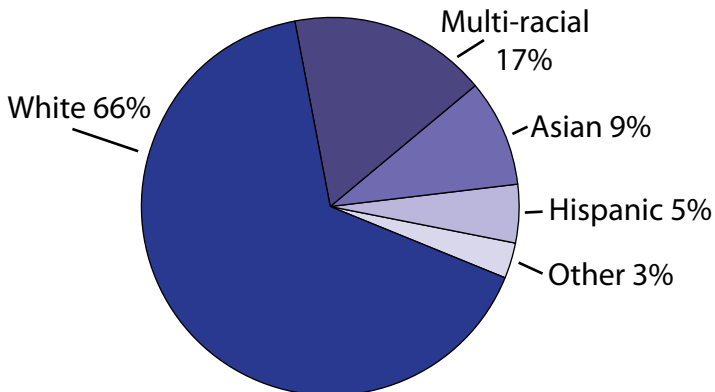

Diverse Students

2007-2008 Parent Teacher Club (PTC)

Parent Teacher Club is the volunteer arm of Assumption Catholic School. It is through this body that all families commit their time and energy to ensure the smooth daily operation of school activities. All parents are encouraged to attend the general PTC meeting each month.

An 11-person executive committee oversees 37 committee chairs who utilize volunteers to provide faith-filled programs, events and services for our students, as well as critical fundraising manpower. In 2007-2008, PTC fundraisers provided critical dollars to the school's operating budget.

PTC volunteers committed more than 8,000 hours of combined volunteer time to our school. They assisted with the Annual Fund, Auction, SCRIP, Spagetti Dinner and Fun Run. In addition, parents assisted staff and oversaw our extensive list of co-curricular activities, which would not be possible without their dedication.

Assumption Catholic School Foundation

The ASC Foundation is the financial investment arm of Assumption Catholic School. It is through this body that we will grow our school's long-term financial stability. Annual gifts of treasure from our school families, parish members and community are properly invested to generate sustainable earnings for our school, with the goal of keeping Catholic education available for all who seek it. The Foundation's board of directors oversees both endowed and non-endowed funds reserved for the school, as well as annual contributions for the operating budget. Foundation meetings are open and held quarterly in October, February, May and August.

In 2007-2008, Assumption Catholic School Foundation transferred \$11,700 in endowment earnings to the school, as well as \$10,000 from the Foundation's unrestricted Educational Enrichment Fund, which supplemented tuition assistance and special program needs.

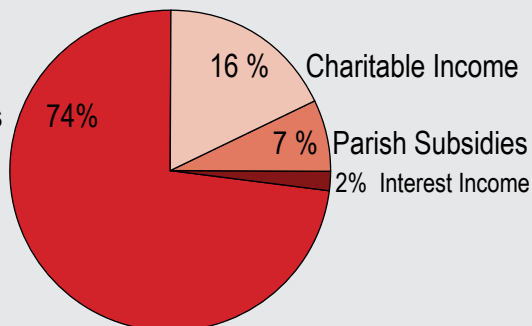

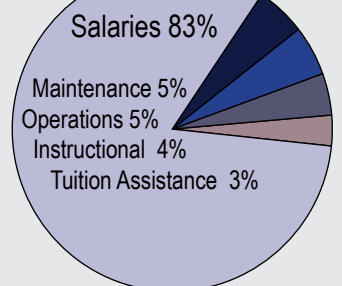

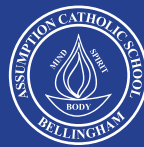
